## DISTRICT UNIT AWARDS

### Advancement Award

The District Advancement Award is presented to Packs and Troops who have done an outstanding job of supporting rank advancement for every Scout in their unit. To earn this award, at least 75% of Scouts registered as of December 31, must have advanced at least one rank during the calendar year.

### Camping Award

The District Camping Award is presented to units who have an exemplary record of participation in camping and other outdoor Scouting activities.

### Key 3 Quality Unit Leader's Award

The District Key 3 Quality Unit Leader's Award is presented to those units who have demonstrated exceptional levels of achievement in all areas of their Scouting program, including advancement, camping, community service, unit activities, adult leadership training, communication and participation at District events.



## DISTRICT EMERITUS AWARD

The Emeritus Award is a Roadrunner District award established in 2000 to honor Scouters who have continued to be active in unit, district and council events even though their children have “graduated” from the Scouting program. ## COUNCIL AWARD SILVER BEAVER

The Silver Beaver award was created by the National Council and first presented in 1931 as an award program to be utilized by a local council with National Council approval of the recipients. The first year they were presented nationally (1931), they were on a pocket ribbon like an Eagle Scout medal. After that first year they were placed on neck ribbons and remain so to this day. The award was originally a male only award. In 1971 the Silver Fawn award was created and presented as a separate but equal award for women Scouters. Starting in 1974 the Silver Beaver was awarded to both men and women and the Silver Fawn was discontinued.

Each year Longhorn Council's Executive Board, under the approval of the National Council of the Boy Scouts of America, awards the Silver Beaver to registered Scouters who have preformed noteworthy service of exceptional character to youth within the territory served by the Council.
